- 4 **False** There are 6 principal committees and a senior committee
- 5 **False** There are 38 Deputies but there are 40 members of the States of Deliberation (38 Deputies and 2 Alderney Representatives)
- 6 **False** The States members vote
- 7 **True** There are 5 (or sometimes 6) Deputies in each Department
- 8 **True** You can vote at 16
- 9 **True** The States meet approximately every 3 weeks but they will break for summer recess
- 10 **True** Voting in the States is carried out in French
